
# Do-While

- Structure

```
do  
    statement;  
while(expression);
```

```
do{  
    statements;  
} while(expression);
```


- **expression** is evaluated logically
- Often used in data validation situations

    scanf("%f", &num);  
} while(num < 1 || num >10);
```
