Eclipse Setup

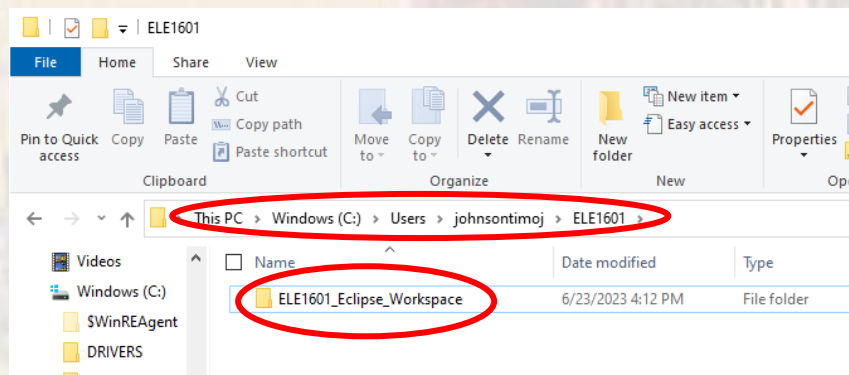
- Folder Setup

- Create a folder for your ELE1601 files

- The directory (folder) must be located in your personal section of windows
 - This should be Windows (C:)\Users\[your_user_name](#)
 - Call the directory (folder) [ELE1601](#)

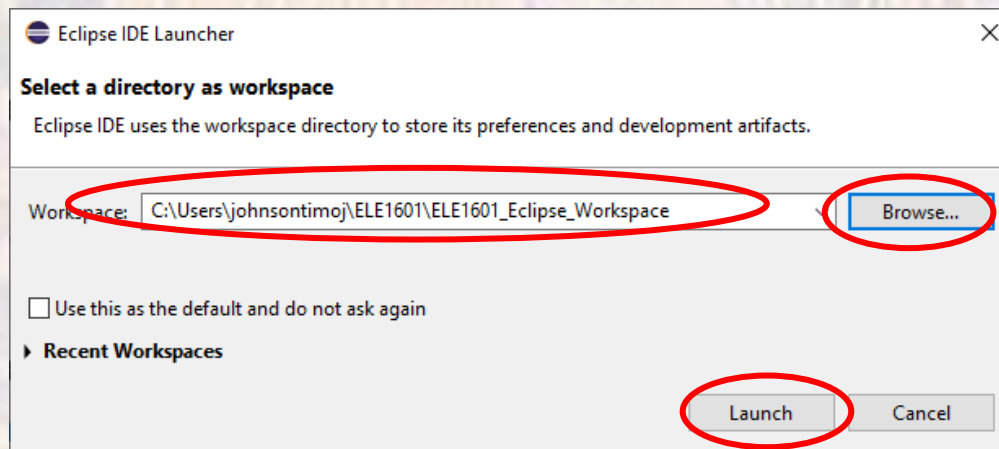
- Create a workspace folder

- A workspace is a folder on your computer that holds all of Eclipse's files and your code files
- **Inside** the ELE1601 directory create a new directory to use with the Eclipse tool
 - Call the directory [ELE1601_Eclipse_Workspace](#)
 - No spaces in the name, use underscore instead (_)



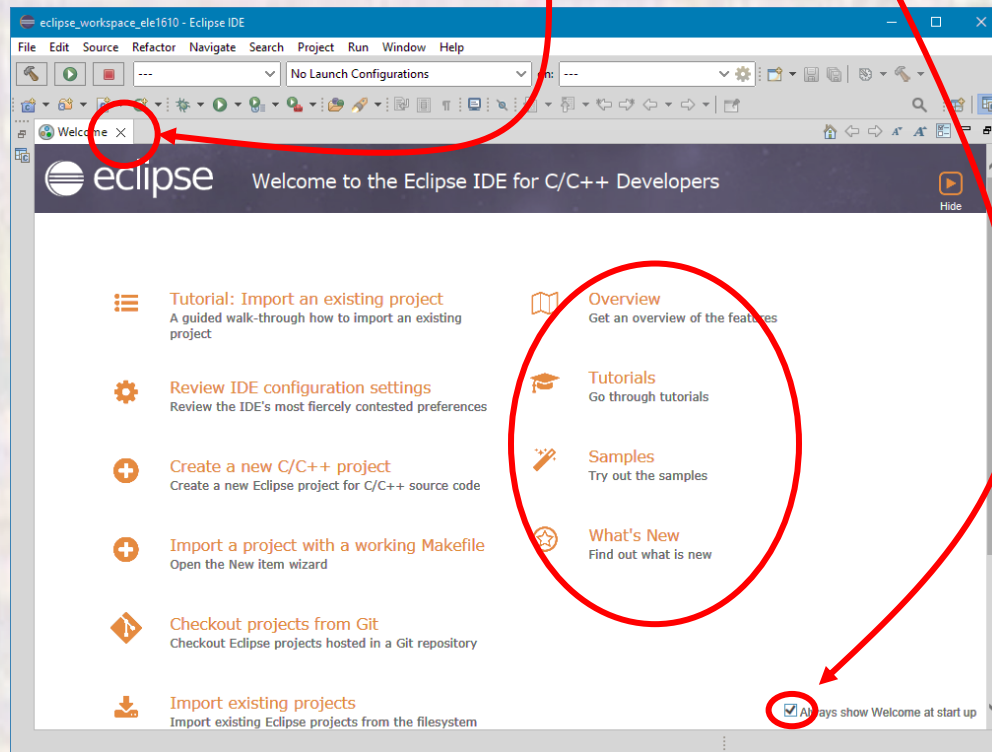
Eclipse Setup

- Open Eclipse (3 ways to do this)
 - Double-click the Desktop Icon (if created)
 - Select the Start Menu icon (if created)
 - Go to C:\Users\your-user-name\eclipse\cpp-2024-03\eclipse and select eclipse.exe
- **Browse** to the **workspace folder** created in the last slide
 - **Select Launch**



Eclipse Setup

- Open Eclipse
 - Note the items in the **Welcome** tab
 - **Check** the **Always show Welcome...** box (optional)
 - For now – just **close** the **tab**

- Open Eclipse
 - Eclipse is now ready to use for this class
 - Exit Eclipse
