

BE Senior Design Copyright Assignment (v. 1.0)

I'm giving you two options regarding copyright protection of your design documentation. One is to relinquish most rights in an explicit statement in your documents. The other is to claim your rights, but assign limited rights to me and MSOE.

Option 1 – Relinquish Most Rights

Include a statement like the following (including the creative commons icon) after your title pages and before your table of contents in all your documents:

This work copyright 2010 by MSOE BE design team 10-X (*your names*).

Permission is granted to copy, distribute, transmit and adapt this work provided it is attributed to the original authors, the use is noncommercial and that any derivative work is distributed under the same or similar license. Contact the authors for additional permissions. See <http://creativecommons.org/licenses/by-nc-nd/3.0/legalcode> for more information.



Option 2 – Claim Rights and Assign

Include a statement like the following after your title pages and before your table of contents in all your documents:

This work copyright 2010 by MSOE BE design team 10-X (*your names*). All rights reserved. Contact the authors for possible permission to use, copy, distribute, transmit or adapt this work.

In this case you need assign reasonable, non-exclusive rights to me and MSOE. This can be done by providing me with a letter or memo containing the following text and signed by every team member.

We, MSOE BE design team 10-X (*your names*), hereby assign Dr. C. Samuel Tritt and the Milwaukee School of Engineering (MSOE) non-exclusive, perpetual rights to use, copy, distribute, transmit and adapt all the capstone design project documentation we have produced provided the work is attributed to us.
